
Is our candidate qualified Designed by Alice Huang Office of the CVMO to serve as the NSM on our Department of Veterans Affairs Reviewed by OLAW for **IACUC?** consistency with PHS Policy 12/08/2016 **Current primary occupation and prior training** are <u>not</u> related to carrying out research involving animals. Examples of some who are disqualified: research staff member named on FALSE an animal use protocol, animal technician who manages routine anesthesia during research procedures, lab technician who has been trained to perform tail snips (even if s/he has never actually been named as a participant on an animal use protocol) TRUE Is not currently responsible for directing other to perform research procedures on animals **FALSE** Example of one who is disqualified: the PI on a project that involves DISQUALIFIED animal research (even if the PI does not personally perform any from serving as the of the procedures on the animals) **NSM** (may serve as another member **TRUE** of the IACUC) Is likely to be perceived by the general public as unbiased with regard to the interests of scientists involved in animal research? **FALSE** Examples of some who are disqualified: VMU Supervisor, health care provider, active scientist in any field (even in a field that does not involve animal research, such as botany, geology, or mathematics), someone who was involved in animal research in the past (even if no longer active) TRUE "Has a naïve attitude with regard to science and scientific FALSE activities" and "is without scientific training"? QUALIFIED TRUE to serve as the **NSM**



"Non-Scientific Member"

One whose training, experience, and current primary occupation are not "scientific"

Ethicist

Members of the clergy

Lawyer

"Scientific"

One with scientific training, or who does not have a naïve attitude toward science and scientific activities

Biological scientists with no experience in animal research

Animal technician who performs routine animal research procedures

VMU Supervisor

Retired scientist who used to conduct animal research, but no longer does Healthcare providers

One trained in science, even if not currently practicing

"Scientific Member"

Practicing scientist experienced in animal research

Scientists
in fields that do not
involve animal research
(e.g. Botany, geology,
mathematics)

Practicing scientist who supervises, but does not personally conduct animal research

Librarian

Those working in business or finance

Instructors in Liberal Arts fields (e.g., English, history)
