
Veterans can now join the groundbreaking Million Veteran Program (MVP) online.


MVP uses data from Veteran partners to better understand issues such as:

# Joining MVP is easy




## VA makes it easy for Veterans to join MVP

To join online, Veterans are asked to:




### SIGN IN

using the same credentials as other VA partners (such as My HealthVet or eBenefits).



### COMPLETE

the consent process and allow access to health records.



### SCHEDULE

an MVP visit to provide a blood sample.



### FILL OUT

surveys about health and lifestyle.

Go to <https://www.mvp.va.gov> and sign in using your existing VA login credentials from one of our secure VA Sign-In Partners such as My HealthVet, DS Logon, or ID.me. Once signed in, you can access your MVP dashboard to view your activity status and read important MVP stories, including news articles and program updates.
