JBVAMC consists of a 200-bed acute care facility and four community-based outpatient clinics (CBOCs), with approximately 2,000 full-time equivalent staff, including 200+ physicians, 450 nurses, and 500+ volunteers, providing care to approximately 62,000 enrolled Veterans. Research Service enjoys Academic Affiliations with Northwestern Univ., Univ. of Chicago, Univ. of Illinois at Chicago, and the School of the Art Institute. Research Service currently administers 94 clinical trials, 42 protocols in Basic Science, and on-going activities in our specific-pathogen-free barrier VMU. JBVAMC enjoys more than 40,000 square feet of space dedicated to research and features its own Institutional Review Board.
